*To Conduct/Arrange/Establish/Maintain many type of Education, Training, Entertainment, Sports, Scholarship, Health, Prevention of Child labour, Women welfare, General Public Welfare, Human-rights and any type of work(s) mentioned detail seperately as follows:-*

- 4. To arrange / establish and maintain centers of adult education, vocational education, technical training, low cost education, computer training, computer related courses, formal & non-formal education. To establish, develop, maintain & conduct any type of school, college, I.T.I. College under N.C.V.T. courses, para Medical, Dental College, Pharmacy College, Engineering College, Teacher training College, B.Ed. College, Libraries, Universities, Laboratories, Skill development Centres, competition, preparation centres, sports training centres, vocational & Technical Training Centres, Research Centres and other Institutions for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general. To establish, maintain and run studentship, scholarship and award programme and render other kind of aid to students including supply of study materials, books, stipend, models and other incentives. To organise programme for the promotions of primary education, formal education, computer & information Technologies, Leadership development, Techno-entrepreneurship Development educational infrastructure research and

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development publish study materials, magazine, books, information materials, Journals, Produce Film, T.V. Serials, documentaries, Audio-Video cassettes on buring social educational, scientific issues & social problem.

- \* To promote awareness of traditional games & arts of India amongst the general public and in particular the younger generation.
- \* To conduct or sponcer performances of sports, Game, Art, Music, Dance, Drama, Fine Arts, Singing, Speech, Hand writing competitions etc.

- \* To establish, maintain, improve or manage and run existing new Art College, Players Colleges for the training of players & Artists.
- \* To associate with any other allied institution oriental projected groups that the Trustees may deem fit.
- \* To arrange, give musical soirees, dance, dramas and promote. To study of theory and practice of music in all its forms and variety for Arts & entertainment & educational purposes.
- \* To arrange for the writing, tape recording, making of records by any

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process whatsoever containing music lessons, music every description of cassettes or other wise.

- \* To import, export, buy, sell & manufacture all instrument of playing instruments & goods, books, magazines for learning, Game and to do all other things which are incidental, ancillary or conducive thereto.
- \* For the furtherance of the objects enumerated above, to undertake, organise and facilitate conferences, seminars, study courses, training programmes, lectures and workshops and similar other activities.
- \* For the furtherance of the objects enumerated above, to maintain liaison with professional institutions and educational & training bodies in various parts of the world.
- \* To act in collaboration with central and state Governments and other appropriate agencies for formulation and execution of projects which would further the objects as set out above and to accept any grants or funds and donations for the said purpose.
- \* To Act as a clearing house of information for various individuals, institutions or other persons interested in the Activities listed above.
- \* To endeavour to establish and maintain liaison with other associations or organised bodies in India & abroad whose objects are in keeping with the objects of this trust.
- \* To purchase, take on lease or in exchange or otherwise acquire hold, possess and dispose of any movable or immovable property which may be deemed necessary, expedient or desirable for any of the objects of this Turst.

4.27. To communicate and coordinate with the Govt. local and public authorities on various issues related to development, welfare and of public interest.

4.28. To construct, maintain, alter, improve or develop any building necessary or convenient for the benefit of the people.

4.29. To spread awarness among people about the need and importance of nature care (Naturopathy) and how for it can change their lives. Nature cure not only treats deseases; which are otherwise impossible to be treated; but also helps come over modern life style desecease like stress, blood pressure, sugar etc. And, above all, it is affordable also. The trust shall found nature cure hospitals.

4.30. To fight against HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases.

4.31. To aware people about various social issues to fight against social evils. To carryout all the programmes for the relief, rehabilitation, welfare and development of women in destitute, old aged, handicapped, street children and child labour, widow, orphan, begger, sex worker, schedule caste, schedule tribes, backward and other under privileged people. To undertake and run the integrated programme on street children rehabitation, Juvenile Justice, Agency,

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Social defence, Civil Defence, Old age home, multi service centre, treatment and rehabilitation of addicts, persons with disabilities, coaching and allied assistance, construction of hostel building and other infrastructure training centres, women empowerment, animal welfare, stop prostitution, eradication of poverty.

4.32. To issue appeals, raise funds and accept gifts, donation subscriptions in cash or in kind any property either movable or immovable for the achievement of the objectives of the trust.

4.33. To acquire, purchase or otherwise own or obtain loan or lease or hire temporality or permanently any movable or immovable property necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the trust. To better the lot of poor needy the trust shall not hesitate to form coprative society and obtain any other license and take franchise, if required.

To aid/assist/provide finance the poor, humble and the needy by way of micro finance. To achieve this objective the trust shall obtain deposits from people in general and the money thus accumulated would be advanced among the poor and needy to enable them to be self reliant seperate groups of needy men and women would be formed and provided the required finance at the bare minimum rate of interest. To safeguard the interests of the poor they would be made financial literates so as to enable them to save themselves

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from the clutches of the money lenders. who soever shall make deposit with the trust shall be entitled to R.B.I. rate of interest. As per the attitude of the poor people they would be given training in the required field and thereafter the process of providing finance would follow. The process of providing loans to the poor shall be made hassle free, easy and without much formalities. Meeting the financial requirements of the poor. The focus of the trust shall always be empowerment of the poor and down trodden.

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- 4.34. To organized and take-up Health, Education and Welfare programmes for the needy & poor women & children. To help girls at the time of marriage.
- 4.35. To promote and protect indian, traditional music, dance, handicraft, handlooms, Art, modern art & literature.
- 4.36. To support the families and relatives of artists for promoting the budding artists in the society.
- 4.37. To give award to the deserving people in the fields of music, art, science and literature to promote grass root level social service, communal harmony, brotherhood and peace.
- 4.38. To establish centre(s) for the promotion of Music, Dance and other

- 4.39. To establish residential and non-residential cultural centers for promoting Music Dance and other Arts.
- 4.40. To work for Environment protection, forestation, Plantation, Waste Land Managment.
- 4.41. To organize vocational training for women and needy people.
- 4.42. To organize awareness camps, health camps, campaign and exhibition.
- 4.43. To aware people about their democratic & fundamental rights.
- 4.44. To promote cottage industries, Khadi, and traditional handicraft.
- 4.45. To advocate poanchayti Raj system among citizens.
- 4.46. To provide various medical services by organizing, Eye Care Motherhood, Child Care, and communicative Diseases.
- 4.47. To check any epidemics and to advocate both permment and temporary measures of Family Planning.
- 4.48. To provide basic medical facility, sanitation, general health care and

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other needful support which can be helpful for public to overcome sufferings and agony of any natural disaster and to facilitate them to rehabilitate.

4.49. To provide medical, emotional, psychological, support to senior citizens of our society by setting up, senior citizen homes, old-age homes and other entertainment centres so that these people must be not neglected.

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4.50. To undertake activities for sensitizing people to preserve the natural resources of our nation and to maintain the ecological balance of the area.

4.51. To provide and facilitate legal assistance to underprivileged and poor section of society to fight for their rights and justice.

4.52. To promote, encourage and facilitate research programmes and trainings in the field of public health, education and empowerment.

4.53. To arrange and organize religious, social and cultural programmes for all human beings from time to time.

4.54. To create a sense of brotherhood, love, humanity, affection, cooperation and friendship amongst the members of the trust and the beneficiaries,



- 4.55. To make best efforts for promotion, development and protection of the beneficiaries/target population and help them in distress.
- 4.56. To help poor, widows, handicapped, orphans, old aged, mentally retarded and under privileged section of the community.
- 4.57. To run/ operate different types of education program/school like formal, non-formal, pre-school for the education, development of under privileged children of the community.
- 4.58. To run the different types of health programme to raise the health status of vulnerable groups, poor and needy.
- 4.59. To work for the empowerment and sensitization of women, adolescents and children.
- 4.60. To make up efforts for the education, welfare and development of women, children and backward community in both urban and rural areas throughout the country.
- 4.61. To provide medical facilities in the working locality (if required) such as family planning centers, dispensaries, hospitals etc.

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- 4.62. To run and open school(s) for the welfare and upliftment of the needy children and also run adult education programmes.
- 4.63. To publish books, magazines, charts, issue related IEC (information, Education and communication) materials and other periodical illustration for generating the in come for the trust for the benefit of its aims.
- 4.64. To work and fight against discrimination based on Cast, Creed, Colour, Gender, Religion, Faith, Race & Nationality.
- 4.65. To open/ run/ manage institute/ college of higher/ professional/ vocational education in any part of the country for providing quality education and training to youth and children.
- 4.66. To promote and protect natural herbs and plants by cultivation, preservation, storage, processing, demonstration, creating botanical garden and providing any type(s) of agricultural training.
- 4.67. To establish / run/ manage/ hospitals, mobile health clinics, research centre to provide health care, counseling and referral services for all kinds of illness and deceases.
- 4.68. To promote traditional therepies like yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation

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Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Allopathy, Reiki etc.

4.69. To establish, build or manage hostels, short stay homes, rehabilitation centers, shelters crenches, child care centre or children's home concelling centres and help line centers for women, children old aged persons drug addicts and needy persons.

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4.70. To work for the welfare of agricultural workers, farmers, unorganised labours, industrial labours and migrated labourers.

4.71. To form women group, youth self help groups; aged group, adolescent group, children group/club, community leader group and group of volunteers.

4.72. To promote traditional games along with the contemporary sports amongst youth & others.

4.73. To work for the welfare & support the families of martyrs and prisoners.

4.74. To work against the exploitation of animals & birds and make sincere efforts to protect them.



- 4.75. To celebrate annual day of the trust every year as cultural & social event.
- 4.76. To establish Citizen Forum (s) and Resident Welfare Association (s) for the development of high values of the unity, brotherhood, communal harmony and peace.
- 4.77. To promote and support voluntary donation of blood, eyes and other parts of human body for the benefit of the needy patients.
- 4.78. To take-up, initiate or assist social development activities or welfare programmes for bringing positive changes in the lives of the common people.
- 4.79. To save/ protect National Heritage, Buildings or Places of the Archelological & historic importance/interest.
- 4.80. To spread the teachings & thoughts of great leaders, philosophers, thinkers, reformers and saints.
- 4.81. To conduct and undertake the research of technologies advancement, productivity enhancement, cost effectiveness technologies and methodologies in the field of agriculture, allied industries, cottage industries, veterinary and co-operatives. To conduct plantation, including medicinal plant, edible oils & non-edible oils cultivation, bio-

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and financial help.

- 6.8 To receive the honorarium or salary against his/her services or involvement in any of the project or programme run by the Trust, which must be decided by the Board of Trustees and approved by the Chairman / Settlor.
- 6.9 To authorize person (s) to sign or execute documents on behalf of the Trust.
- 6.10 To grant receipts for aid or donation received.
- 6.11 To grant special power of attorney to represent the Trustees in connection with any legal or other proceedings.
- 6.12 To acquire land or building on lease or by way of purchase.
- 6.13 To compromise, compound or refer to Arbitration all actions, proceeding and disputes relating to Trust property or properties.
- 6.14 To sell or give on rent/lease or on hire any immovable or movable property of the Trust for a certain period (s) on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit and proper from time to time.
- 6.15 To open any type of bank account (s) whether saving account, current account, fixed or otherwise, in the name of the Trust or institution (s) or programme (s) & project run by the Trust with any scheduled bank(s)

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or post office (s) and to operate such account(s) with the signature of the only Settlor and other the written direction by the Settlor and joint Signature by the Settlor and Treasurer or Secretary. The financial year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March and the account of the Trust or institution(s) or programme(s) shall get audited by a chartered accountants to be appointed by the Board of Trustees and the fees for auditors, if paid, be a part of outgoing amounts from the Trust Fund.

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- 6.16 To give guarantee of the assets and property of the Trust including the bank guarantee on behalf of the Trust to corporate bodies, persons firms, institutions as the Trustees may decide from time to time. The Trustees shall not be personally liable for such guarantee of the securities.
- 6.17 To gift, lease and transfer the immovable and movable properties of the Trust.
- 6.18. To appoint lawyer, advocate to file and defend suit or suits filed for and against the Trust and or in the name of the Trust and also file suits for financial and other disputes or dues with different parties and sign execute such application, petition documents for such proceedings and delegate powers to the officers, employee(s) staff(s) and Trustee(s) for such proceedings(s) as required from time to time.
- 6.19 To appoint new member or members of Board of Trustees by a resolution and to discharge any of the Trustee, who becomes bankrupt or acts in any manner prejudicial to the interest of

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objects of the Trust or is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or becomes of unsound mind or is otherwise unfit to continue as Trustee, by resolution passed by simple majority of members present and voting in the meeting of Board of Trustees and other by the direction of settlor.

- 6.20 To appoint from time to time on such terms and conditions as trustee may determine a Secretary, Manager, and other officer(S) or member(S) of staff for carrying out the activities of the Trust and to remove such Secretary, Manager, and other officer(s) or member(s) of staff other by the direction of settlor.
- 6.21 After defraying all necessary expenses incurred in the collection or realization the income from the Trust fifty percent (50%) of the balance of the income shall be kept in a reserve fund to be utilized when in the opinion of the Board of Trustees there is any emergency and the remaining income may be utilized for the purpose of the Trust.
- 6.22 The Trustees shall invest the Trust fund in government securities, saving certificates, fixed deposits or in any other form of investment authorized under provisions of INDIAN TRUST ACT and INDIAN INCOME TAX ACT, 1961, as they shall deem expedient.
- 6.23 It has further been decided that as and when the Trust is closed or dissolved all the funds of the Trust shall be transferred to the other recognized public charitable Trust having similar objectives.

Every such question shall be decided by a majority of the Trustees present and voting. Any action or decision of such majority shall be as valid as if it was done or made by the all Trustees. The chairman/ settlor shall have a casting vote.
- 6.25 The settlor shall hold his office till his life time and after his death the new settlor shall be, appoint from his family member.
- 6.26 All matters not provided for in this Trust deed but necessary for the administratin of the Trust of for giving effect to the objectives of the Trust may by resolution(s) made by the Board of Trustees carried by a special majority of two third of total number of the Trustees.
